The Al Act is a Gamechanger for the global Tech-Industry and a huge challenge for companies.



The European Parliament is currently elaborating a legal framework for the use of trustworthy Al. Companies should start informing themselves about the upcoming restrictions now.

- Companies whose AI system is used by European users
- Companies whose Al generated output is used within the EU

WHAT NEED COMPANIES TO DO?

- Identify affected AI, classify risk levels & check compliance
- Adaption of launched & planned Al systems according to the legal framework
- Implementation of additional requirements, e.g., establishment of risk management system

WHY DO WE NEED THIS REGULATION?

- Ensure ethical & trustworthy use of AI systems
- Protection of fundamental human rights & consumer rights
- Worldwide first legal framework for AI with global impact

HOW WILL AI BE CLASSIFIED?

- The requirements to be fulfilled result from the respective risk level of an AI system
- The classification is based on seven key principles
- (Technical) robustness & safety
- Accountability
- Privacy & Data Governance
- Human agency & Oversight
- Transparency
- Diversity, non-discrimination & Fairness
- Societal & environmental well-being
- Rule of thumb: the higher the risk, the more comprehensive the requirements to be met

WHY SHOULD I START NOW?

- Non-compliance can result in fines up to 35,000,000 € or 7% of companies' annual worldwide turnover
- Avoid potential loss of sales, e.g., due to decommissioning
